- Perform testing and operational checks on repaired equipment to verify proper performance and ensure compliance with

manufacturers' specifications.

- Carry out scheduled preventive maintenance, including cleaning, lubricating, servicing and adjusting equipment and components.
- Inspect, service and repair attachments and working equipment, including harvesting and tillage equipment, blades, ploughs, winches and side booms.
- Perform maintenance and repair work on heavy trucks and trailers, as required.
- Complete maintenance and repair activities in accordance with workplace safety procedures, manufacturers' recommendations and applicable standards.
